5. Remembrance Day virtual presentation shared with all classes on Nov 10, African Drumming and Arts workshops for students in 3 to 6, Assessment and Evaluation Day, Photo Retake Day, Lacrosse NS workshop in gym, Reports, Parent/Teacher, PD days
PLC work - dedicated to Reading focus and Math initiative - focus on reading instruction P to 3, and math instruction 4 to 6. Each classroom has a selected group of focus students that received daily small group reading instruction. In grades 4 to 6, teachers are working on planning for and developing 30 minutes lessons a day on fact fluency.
Student Success Planning - September 57% of students meeting expectations for reading, December 71% of students meeting expectations for reading
Writing December 78% meeting expectations Math December 83% meeting expectations
